Her subjects (African Americans) are bold, strong representations who stare directly at the viewer, resulting in mysterious, moving portraits in bold colors.

In her own words, her goal is to “perfect my gift from God. I desire to be as accurate in my storytelling as Rockwell; to learn the mystery of contrast as Caravaggio; to draw one line as poetically as Wyeth and finally to interpret images as superbly as Sargent.” She rediscovered her passion for art late in life, and she’s tackled her re-found ability wholeheartedly.
