

MATT MAUST & MATT WIGNALL:
Your Alimony Check Won't Buy a Bigger Room
At FOUND GALLERY, *March 1st – March 31st, 2008*

LOS ANGELES — This March, Cold War Kids' bassist Matt Maust returns to Found Gallery to display his collage-based art documenting the band's latest tour. This time, Maust has created fewer limited-edition pieces – single-colored silk-screen prints using Matt Wignall's photography of the band as a base.

Much like his previous show, Maust's new works offer the viewer a snapshot of life on the road with the band. The pieces will feature some text-only work, along with some representational imagery. The majority of the sources and subjects are the band on tour during their down time, using imagery mostly from the East Coast as well as Europe.

Joining Maust will be Matt Wignall, the band's official photographer. Wignall will show brand new photographs of the band, mostly in black & white.

No word yet on whether the Cold War Kids will reprise their surprise performance from last time...but one can hope!
