WHAT: The Micro Gestalt show presents an intricate installation of over 400 tiny pieces from four artists, working collaboratively. The art is presented on numerous small blocks of wood, each sold separately, that are ultimately combined for larger effect.

The four artists who collaborated on the installation are Airom Bleicher, Courtney Reid, Alex Schaefer, and Jim Holyoak. Bleicher, who masterminded the project, is an Australian raised and educated artist living in Los Angeles.
